## What You Can't Claim – Self-Employed Expense Checklist (UK 2025)

Common expenses HMRC will reject — no matter what your mates say.

<b>X</b> Expense	<b>ategory</b>	♥ Why You Can't Claim It
Daily food & drink	Personal Expense	Only allowable if part of <b>overnight travel</b>
Personal clothing	Appearance	Must be protective or <b>branded</b> uniform
Haircuts or grooming	Appearance	HMRC sees this as <b>personal</b> , even if client-facing
Gym memberships	Lifestyle	Only allowed if you're a <b>fitness pro</b> (e.g. PT, dancer)
Gifts to yourself	Personal Spend	A business can't give <b>gifts to its</b> <b>owner</b>
Netflix / Spotify	Entertainment	Only claimable if <b>essential to your trade</b> (e.g. DJ, critic)
Full mortgage or rent	Home	Only a <b>portion</b> is allowed for actual business use
Pets & pet care	Lifestyle	Only claimable if <b>directly used</b> in your business

<b>X</b> Expense	<b>ategory</b>	♥ Why You Can't Claim It
Parking or speeding fines	Travel	Never allowable — personal legal liability
Family holidays	Travel	No business purpose = fully disallowed
Personal mileage / commute	Travel	Only business journeys count — not commuting
Kids' school or childcare	Family	Always personal — not tied to business income generation
